

2011 NOTICE OF RACE at SLYC



(1) Dates:

The season starts Memorial Day weekend & ends Labor Day.
No club races are scheduled on August 3-7.
Organizing Authority: Spring Lake Yacht Club

(2) Races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*: www.ussailing.org

(3) Other Class Requirements & Rules:

(4) Conditions of entry:

Club membership and boat registration paid in full before the start of the race. A guest may crew up to two weekends per season. Only club members may skipper a yacht for points. Scoring remains with the skipper if ownership changes.

(5) Series & regatta warning signal times:

Sat/Sun/*Mon @11:30am: MC, then Butterfly
Sat/Sun/*Mon @2:00pm: E, then C
Wednesday Junior Butterfly Series: 1:15pm
Memorial Day Regatta: May 28, 29, *30
Fourth of July Regatta: July 2, 3, *4
Labor Day Regatta: September 3, 4, *5

(7) Scoring:

35 races are scheduled for the Season Series. 34 races are scheduled for the Wednesday Junior Series; two back-to-back, each week. It is necessary to sail 60% of the completed series races to qualify (rounded up). Each race a yacht sails in excess of the number needed to qualify for trophies will be scored as a bonus race for that yacht. Bonus races will be scored as one place better than actual position. No race shall be declared official unless two or more entrants come to the starting line.

Four races are scheduled for each class in the Memorial Day, 4th of July, & Labor Day Regatta. No score will be excluded for the regatta, including DNC. All races where the entrant came to the starting line count toward the season total, including DNS but not DNC. The back-to-back race day for the MC/Butterfly is scheduled for Saturday & E/C on Sunday of the holiday regatta.

(8) Trophies:

Trophies will follow the last race of the day for each regatta & after the last race on Labor Day for all series.

(9) Risk:

Competitors participate in the regatta/series entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race(RRS). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
